## RULES FOR SUMMER SOCCER CAMP REIMBURSEMENT

The Pal Mac Soccer Club is pleased to help involved players offset their expenses of attending summer soccer camps, through the awarding of points associated with fundraising and other involvement in club activities, as follows:

| 1. Annual Mothers' Day Flower Sale                 | <b>1 point</b> per plant sold.         |
| 2. Working in concession stand (fall/indoor games) | <b>3 points</b> per shift <sup>1</sup> |
| 3. Working at CanalTown Days                       | <b>3 points</b> per shift              |
| 4. Working at Homecoming Breakfast                 | <b>3 points</b> per shift              |
| 5. Miscellaneous Activities (park cleanup, etc.)   | <b>at Club's discretion</b>            |

### Notes:

- Points accumulate from September 1 through August 31 of each year.
- Points are tracked by the chairperson(s) of any eligible activity, and submitted to the Registrar for record-keeping.
- Each point can be redeemed for \$1.00 toward the cost of any approved soccer camp that the player has attended in the current year.
- Points must be redeemed (using the website voucher system) by October 31 of the year in which they were earned.
- Points not redeemed, do not roll over from one year to another.
- Credits earned by family or friends of players may be donated (transferred) to one or more players. See the Club Registrar to arrange.

<sup>1</sup> Minimum shift length is defined by the committee chairperson for each event. Working less than that amount will result in fewer (or no) points, at the chairperson's discretion.
