This is a recreation tournament only. Registering teams must consist of athletes from home school.

*All registration fees must be included with registration forms. No day of tournament payment will be arranged.

*Concession will be available throughout the tournament.

Tournament Rules

There will be NO warm-up on the playing floor; warm-ups can be done in the small gym with coach supervision. No athletes allowed in the small gym without the supervision of their coach.

Players

Must wear shin guards.

May not play on or have their name on more than one roster in the same age group. must be enrolled in school and be under 19 years old.

Substitutions

On the fly, near the bench area only or on a dead ball (goal kicks, restarts.)

Must not interfere with the play.

PENALTY: indirect kick from point of infraction

Out of Bounds

Ball hits above the dark blue line or hits ceiling and fixtures attached to ceiling

PENALTY: indirect kick from point of infraction

Fouls

Penalties - all indirect from point of infraction

Serious/intentional defensive fouls in the penalty area will result in a penalty kick.

Poor Sportsmanship

1st offense - athlete will sit out remainder of the game

2nd offense - athlete is out for the tournament

SERIOUS INTENTIONAL INFRACTIONS MAY RESULT IN A YELLOW OR RED CARD:

1st vellow card-2 minutes in penalty

2nd yellow card-ejection from the game

Goalkeeper

Must have one foot inside the box before they can touch the ball with their hands

May throw the ball (must hit the floor, wall, or a player by mid court)

May play ball with their feet

May not punt the ball

On intentional pass back from a teammate, the keeper may not use their hands.

Keeper has 5 seconds to release the ball.

Defense must be 5 feet away on restarts and direct/indirect kicks

Overtime (Playoffs only)

- 1) One 5-minute straight overtime, first one to score wins.
- 2) If no score after first overtime a second 5-minute overtime will be played. After each minute the clock will be stopped and a player will be pulled until one team scores. Keeper can be pulled.
- 3) If time runs out the 2 remaining players will keep playing until someone scores. If infraction happens during this part of overtime it will be a direct kick at the point where infraction occurred.
- 4) No subbing is allowed once overtime starts, players on court at end of regulation must stay on court.
